Our terms and conditions say any organisation or group hiring Beaudesert equipment are responsible for ensuring the competence of instructors and completing their own risk assessments, but as a minimum the Beaudesert risk assessment will be followed.

We expect visiting groups & organisations to hold appropriate insurance and have procedures of ensuring their instructors are competent for the activities they are providing.

There are a few activities we insist on seeing qualifications & insurance. These are:

Our instructors are trained to run activities safely. We follow best practice by risk assessing our activities and creating safe ways of instructing the activities. We review and adopt relevant national guidelines for each activity. Senior Staff are experienced and qualified in a range of activities. All our activities have a named Technical Adviser.

All our instructors will have been approved to lead or assist activities by a Technical Adviser Approved Scheme.

Our safety systems have been externally inspected, and we hold an AALA Licence, Adventure Mark & LOTC Quality Badge.
