

Introduction

Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre is located on the edge of Cannock Chase, Staffordshire in an area of outstanding natural beauty. With 120 acres of parklands and wooded areas we have a perfect activity setting. We have a wide range of activities including Sit on Kayaks, Coracles, Raft Building, Via Ferrata, Abseiling on natural rock, Zip Line, High Ropes, Archery, Climbing Wall, Rifle Shooting and Tomahawks. We have multiple accommodation lodges, camping spaces and we are a thriving residential centre for Scouts, Guides, Youth Groups and Schools. The Centre is managed by The Beaudesert Trust. The Strategic Management of the centre is led by the Centre Manager who is currently supported in the day to day operational management by a Catering Manager and a Parks Officer.

Prior to Covid the centre was going through a significant period of growth and had doubled its turnover in the previous 4 years. The centre was on target to continue growing.

The activities team is in the process of being rebuilt following a complete restructure during the last 18 months. Currently we are using freelance and casual instructors and the department is being led by the Centre Manager with significant input from the technical advisor. The appointed Activity Manager will report to the Centre Manager and take over

management of the activity team and help with the recruitment of 2 lead instructors in 2022, 8 oversees volunteers and a team of casual and freelance instructors as we rebuild and progress in 2022. They will work very closely with the Technical Advisor to ensure the very best standard of safety. As part of the management team the Activity manager will be responsible for duty manager shifts to lead the operational delivery. During the next 18 months to 2 years the Activity Manager will also be involved with reception and sales duties therefore exceptional written and verbal commination is required.

Having survived long periods of closure, this is an extremely exciting time to join the centre as we rebuild and grow again. There is lots of opportunity to contribute to creating new processes to make us more efficient and to the overall growth of the centre.
