Health and Safety General Policy Statement

The Beaudesert Trust T/A Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre

The Beaudesert Trust recognises that it has responsibilities for the health and safety of our workforce whilst at work and others who could be affected by our work activities. We will assess the hazards and risks faced by our workforce in the course of their work and take action to control those risks to an acceptable, tolerable level.

Our managers and supervisors are made aware of their responsibilities and required to take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety, health and welfare of our workforce and anyone else likely to be affected by operation of our business. Health and Safety is a collective responsibility between managers, staff and users of the site.

This business intends meeting its legal obligations by providing and maintaining a safe and healthy working environment so far as is reasonably practicable. This will be achieved by:


- Providing leadership and adequate control of identifiable health and safety risks
- Consulting with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety.
- Providing and maintaining safe plant and equipment.
- Ensuring the safe handling and use of substances.
- Providing information, instructions, training where necessary for our workforce, taking account of any who do not have English as a first language.
- Ensuring that all workers are competent to do their work and giving them appropriate training.
- Preventing accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
- Activity Managing and supervising health and safety at work.
- Having access to competent advice and annual audits via our external health and safety consultants
- Aiming for continuous improvements to our health and safety performance and management through regular (at least annual) review and revision of this policy.
- The provision of the resource required to make this policy and our health and safety arrangements effective.

We also recognise:

- Our duty to co-operate and work with other employers and their workers when their workers come on to our premises or do work for us.

To help us achieve our objectives and ensure that our employees are safe while carrying out their duties under health and safety legislation whilst at work, we will also remind our employees of their duty to take reasonable care for their ourselves and others who might be affected by their actions. These duties are explained, these duties are explained during induction in the first week of employment.

Health and safety posters are posted in the cafeteria kitchen, estate office, reception, cleaning store and the activity hut.
