Rope burn	Group & Instructor	Brief people to go slow through the spider's web, watch where they are going and be careful.	Trivial <i>if controls are followed</i>
Hitting head	Group & Instructor	Brief the group about them hitting their heads on some elements as they might have to crawl under them. Helmets provided as participants blindfolded.	Trivial <i>if controls are followed</i>
Slips, Trips and Falls	Group & Instructor	Group to be warned about tripping hazards, e.g. tree roots and stones. Instructor to check the course and, if possible, remove any tripping hazards prior to activity starting.	Trivial <i>if controls are followed</i>
Confusion leading to participants not doing the task correctly	Group	Instructor to be always near participants to help guide them through the course. Participants will be going slowly as they are blindfolded.	Trivial if controls are followed
Unwanted Physical contact	Group	Instructor to provide comprehensive brief to highlight risks and expectations. Two participants to be sighted at all times, unless the Instructor is leading a group across an open field with the visiting leader present. Participants to hold the shoulder of the participant ahead, ensuring a straight arm at all times. Instructor to stop the participants at particularly challenging elements leading participants one at a time. All participants are freely opting to participate in this activity and have the option to withdraw from the activity at any given point.	Trivial <i>if controls are followed</i>
Negative effects on Mental health	Group	Ensure all participants are comfortable wearing a blindfolded. Explain to participants they have the right to opt out or withdraw from this session at any point.	Trivial if controls are followed
